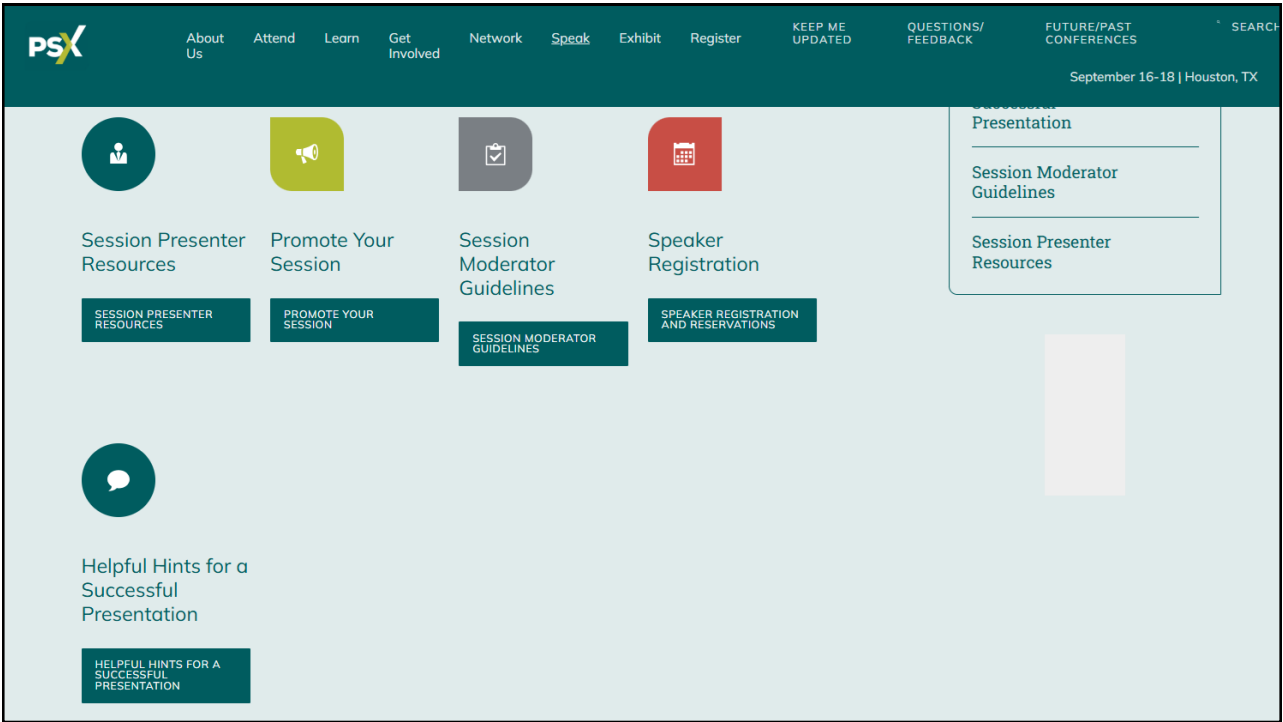

Action Items and Deadlines

- **April 16, 2025** — Registration launches for PSX. All speakers and moderators are required to register and pay applicable full conference, or one-day registration fees. There are no speaker discounts available for registration.
- **April 17, 2025** — Log in to the online speaker center to sign the speaker agreement, update your contact details, upload your bio/photo, and complete the Session Broadcasting, Recording & Materials Form.
- **July 13, 11:59 p.m. Eastern, 2025** — Register for PSX 2025 by this date to receive the advance rate discount.
- **September 4, 2025** — Upload a copy of your presentation or other handouts (optional) if you wish attendees to have access to it on the conference's mobile app.
- **September 15, 2025** — Workshop presentation date.
- **September 16-18, 2025** — Education and Express Session presentation dates.



Registration reminder

- All presenters are required to register and are responsible for any associated costs
- Main conference (Tuesday - Thursday) presenters and moderators are required to register for the conference and pay the applicable full, or one-day registration fee



Moderators' Roles & Responsibilities

Roles & Responsibilities

Primary Responsibilities include:

- General Announcements (such as a replacement speaker)
- Introduction to the Session and the Speakers
- Keep the session on schedule
- Assist with Q&A
- Remind attendees to fill out the evaluation

General Guidelines

- Expect questions to be asked and answered
- PSS encourages scientific debate, open communication, healthy discussion, and respect for a diversity of opinions
- All session personnel, presenters, and attendees should conduct themselves in a professional manner
- In the unlikely event of a disagreement, disruption, or emergency, go immediately to Registration and request staff assistance
- If at any time you feel the session is not being presented in a vendor neutral fashion, contains a sales pitch, or have other feedback on the session or speakers, go to Registration to speak with PSS staff and include commentary on the session evaluation

General Announcements

At the start of a session, Moderators should do the following from the front of the room:

- Identify the session title
- Introduce themselves
- Advise the audience of any last-minute presenter changes not already advertised
- Briefly introduce each presenter
 - The biographies need to make these introductions are posted on the conference webpage and mobile app
- When a presenter's time has run out, politely thank them and firmly move on to the next presentation

It is important to make sure each presenter stays on schedule (this includes not ending early)

General Announcements

- Locate lighting controls and emergency exits in case of an emergency
- Please announce to the audience the location of the exits in case of emergency
- Locate audiovisual (A/V) technicians; An A/V technician will be available to troubleshoot any problems
- Note this person's location before the session starts
- Announce that standing in the back of the room or in the aisles is prohibited (as advised by the fire marshal) unless it is to accommodate individuals with disabilities

- Evaluations provide valuable information on the suitability of topics and effectiveness of speakers and are used by staff and volunteer groups for future conference planning

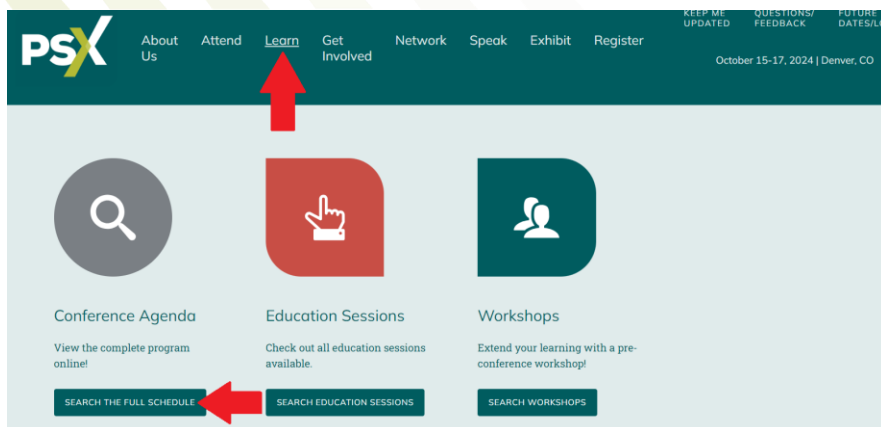

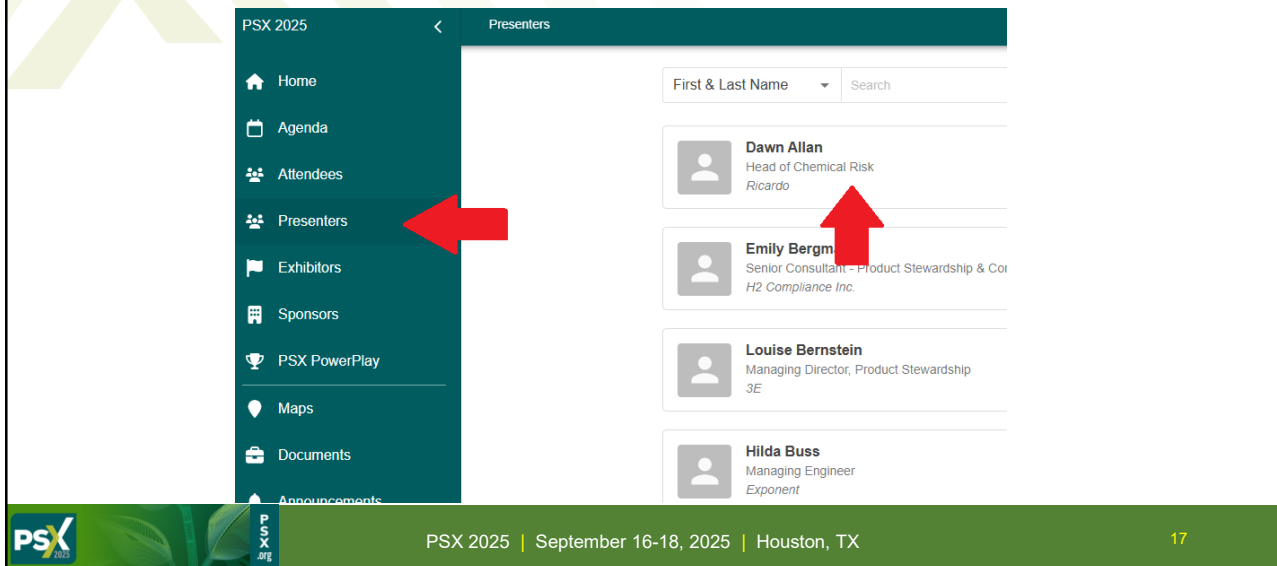

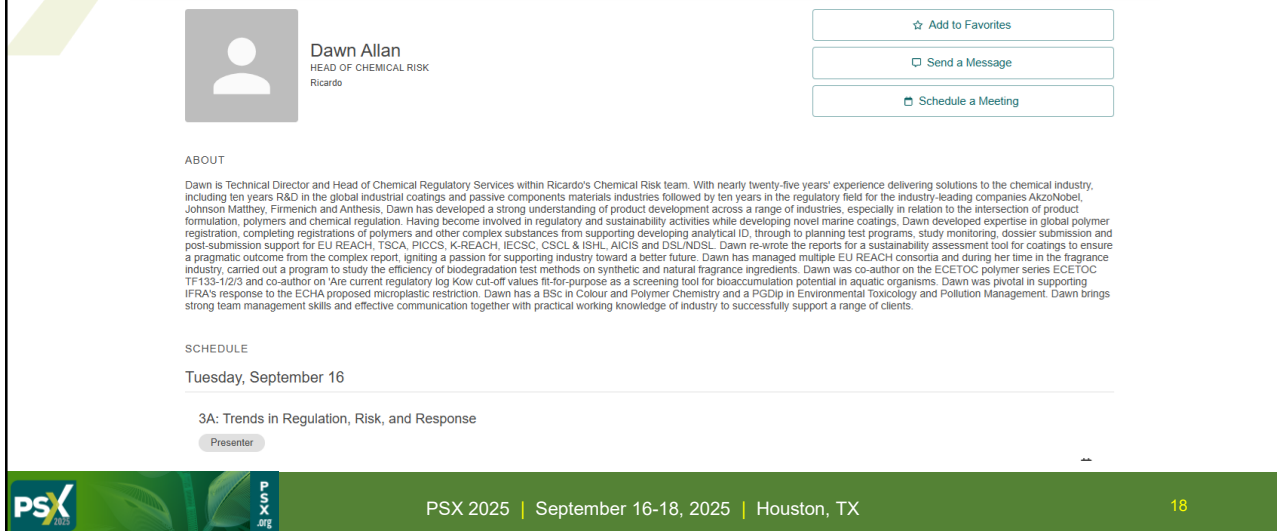

Speaker Introductions

- You are not required to contact speakers beforehand to do this, but you can if you would like (email staff for speaker emails if you want to contact them before the session)
