AIHA Volunteer Group/Project Team Excellence Awards Policy and Procedures

Approved June 2025; Revised July 2025

Purpose

The AIHA Volunteer Group/Project Team Excellence Awards are presented to volunteer groups (VGs) or project teams (comprising one or more VGs working toward a common project or task) that have been selected by Board liaisons as the most supportive of advancing a specific domain of the current AIHA Strategic Plan.

NOTE: Members can also be recognized by their peers for their individual contributions to the association and/or the profession. These types of accolades are reflected under the VG Named Awards or the AIHA Named Awards programs, separate from this program.

Eligibility

The AIHA Volunteer Group/Project Team Excellence Awards are presented to volunteer groups (VGs) or project teams (comprising one or more VGs working toward a common project or task).

To ensure fairness and alignment with the purpose of this award, eligibility is limited to advisory groups whose work is primarily **strategic** in nature. Groups that are primarily **operational**, such as those focused on governance, finance, accreditation, event planning, or administrative oversight, are **not eligible**, as their scope and responsibilities do not directly reflect progress against the external-facing domains of AIHA's Strategic Plan.

Award Process

- Project Teams submit their annual reports by January 17, using the revised annual report form which includes a query on how their work contributed to the AIHA strategic plan. Refer to the Annual Report section below for more information on the annual report process.
- Two Board Liaisons are assigned to review the submitted annual reports and nominations for each domain, excluding their respective assigned groups, to avoid potential bias. Each Liaison scores teams based on contributions that reflect the progress made against strategies listed for each domain.
- Board Liaisons meet as a group to review and discuss their selections and rationales for all nominees per domain. The agreed-upon outcome is up to two (2) VG/project team awardees per strategic plan domain.
- In the event of a tie or unresolved selection of Excellence Awardees, the unresolved decision is referred to the President, President-Elect, Vice President, and Past President for final determination.
- The VG/Project Team Excellence Award nominees are presented to the Board of Directors for a vote of approval.
- The Excellence Award recipients will be notified and presented with their awards. The names of the Awarded Project Teams, including those of the individual contributors, will be announced at AIHA Connect, in The Synergist, on the AIHA webpage, and on the individual members' AIHA transcripts.

Annual Report Process

The Annual Report is the Volunteer Group (VG) Chair's official record of VG's activities and accomplishments. The preparation of this report enables VG to evaluate its performance and implement continuous improvement practices. The report also helps to ensure that the work of the VG is recognized and understood by the Board and that VGs work can be placed in the context of AIHA's strategic priorities and content priorities.

Chairs are to submit an Annual Report via the online submission portal January 17. The report should include all activities worked on and/or completed in the previous year. This piece of information is key to determining the annual VG/Project Team Excellence Awards.



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Submission Form Fields
