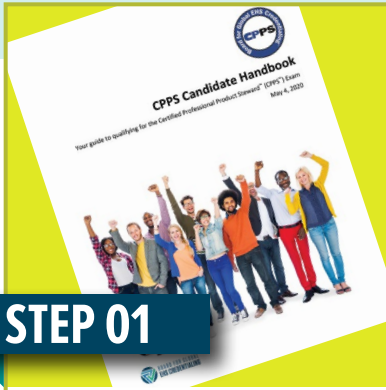




6 STEPS TO EARNING THE Certified Professional Product Steward™ Credential

The new CPPS™ credential, administered by the Board for Global EHS Credentialing (BGC), offers a NEW way to distinguish your expertise and elevate your career as a product stewardship professional.

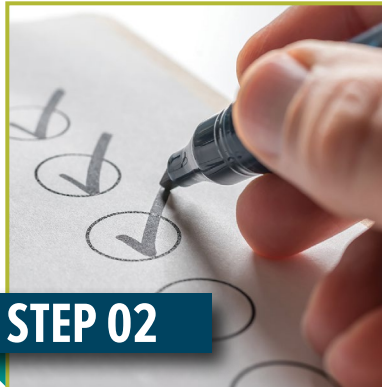
How does it work? Here are the steps to earning your CPPS™:



STEP 01

READ THE CANDIDATE HANDBOOK

Get an overview of the policies and procedures related to eligibility, applying for the exam, and sitting for the exam.



STEP 02

DETERMINE YOUR ELIGIBILITY

View the eligibility requirements outlined in the handbook, including academic, ethics, and work experience.



STEP 03

APPLY FOR THE EXAM

Select a date from the two exam windows offered in March and September. Remember to give yourself time to study!



STEP 06

CELEBRATE

Pass the exam and receive your CPPS credential (valid for 5 yrs). Bragging optional.



STEP 05

TAKE THE EXAM

Answer 150 multiple-choice questions over the course of 3 hours.



STEP 04

PREPARE FOR THE EXAM

Build your subject matter expertise with Product Stewardship Society exam prep resources.

Choose from two exam windows offered each year in the Spring and Fall.

Spring Exam: FEBRUARY 1 - MARCH 30
Application Deadline: December 1

Fall Exam: AUGUST 1 - SEPTEMBER 30
Application Deadline: June 1
